SPECIFICATIONS

SCOPE

The TAMPA SPORTS AUTHORITY, hereinafter referred to as the "Authority", "TSA" or "Raymond James Stadium and Tournament SportsPlex", is requesting a bid proposal to provide approximately 1400 tons of USGA construction sand delivered to Raymond James Stadium, 4201 N. Dale Mabry Highway, Tampa, FL 33607 and approximately 1100 tons of USGA construction sand to the Hillsborough County Tournament SportsPlex, 9330 E. Columbus Drive, Tampa, FL 33619.

SPECIFICS

- 1. A total of 1400 tons of USGA construction sand is needed for the RJS project and 1100 tons for the SportsPlex. All sand should be delivered within a three (3) day period. A copy of the physical soil specification is below.
- 2. The sand must be delivered to RJS in mini-wheeler dump trucks.
- 3. The trucking fuel prices <u>must</u> be guaranteed for the period of the project which is (4/1/2020 thru 6/30/2020).
- 4. Three (3) quality control soil tests (one (1) from each of the approximate 500 tons delivered to RJS) will be taken, with an Owner representative present, and sent to Turf Diagnostics for verification of the USGA sand.
- 5. There must be <u>NO ROCKS</u> present in the delivered USGA construction sand. If rocks are present deliveries will be rejected. <u>SAMPLES ARE MANDATORY AND MUST BE INCLUDED WITH YOUR BID SUBMITTAL.</u>
